

EVENT REGULATIONS

EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

(1) The provisions of these Rules and Regulations apply to the participants of the competition and the audience, as well as all other persons (media representatives, volunteers, Partners/Sponsors, etc.) present on the premises of the EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023 event during its duration (hereinafter referred to as the "Event Participants").

(2) The Event Participants are bound by the provisions of the rules and regulations of the AmberExpo Exhibition and Convention Centre (available at: <https://amberexpo.pl/wp-content/uploads/2022/08/REGULAMIN-OBIEKTU-AMBEREXPO-final-styczen-22.pdf>) and the rules and regulations of the Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk Stadium (available at: https://polsatplusarenagdansk.pl/wp-content/uploads/Regulamin-Stadionu_Polsat_Plus_Arena_Gdansk_aktualizacja_2022.pdf).

(3) The Organiser of the Event is the Foundation for the Development of the Education System (address: Aleje Jerozolimskie 142A, 02-305 Warsaw) and SkillsPoland Sp. z o.o. (address: Aleje Jerozolimskie 142A, 02-305 Warsaw), (hereinafter referred to as "Organiser").

(4) Terms used in these Rules and Regulations, whether in upper or lower case, shall have the following meanings:

a) Event - a public event under the name "EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023" consisting of the competitions in the Competitions indicated in Part II, section 3 of the Regulations, as well as the Opening Ceremony and the Closing Ceremony of the Event.

b) Opening Ceremony - part of the Event comprising the ceremonial opening of the Event.

c) Closing Ceremony - part of the Event comprising the ceremonial closing of the Event.

d) Competition Participant - a person who has entered a Competition and is competing in one of the Competitions.

e) Event Participant - the Contest participant, the audience as well as any other persons (media representatives, volunteers, Partners/Sponsors, etc.) present on the EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023 Event site during the Event,

f) Audience - persons who have registered to attend the event as spectators to observe the competition.



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g) Competition - means the conduct of the competition in the Competitions indicated in Part II, section 3 of the Rules and Regulations.

h) Competitions - the parts of the Competition involving the conduct of the Participants' competition in specific professional competencies, regulated by separate Regulations.

i) WorldSkills Europe - the entity that entrusted the Organisers with the organisation of the Event.

j) Rules and Regulations - these Rules and Regulations of the Event "EuroSkills Gdańsk 2023".

(5) The event will take place on 5-9 September 2023:

- The Opening Ceremony will take place on 5 September 2023 at the Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk located at 1 Pokoleń Lechii Gdańsk, 80-560 Gdańsk, from 19:30 - 22:00;

- The competition will be held on 6-8 September 2023 at the AMBEREXPO Hall located at 11 Żaglowa Street, 80-560 Gdańsk, between 9:00 - 17:00;

- The Closing Ceremony will take place on 9 September 2023 at the Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk located at 1 Pokoleń Lechii Gdańsk, 80-560 Gdańsk, between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.

The venue of the event will be available to the Public, Event Participants and Contestants on 5.09.2023 between 7:30 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. and on 6-8.09.2023 between 8:30 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. and on 9.09.2023 between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. and 9.09.2023 between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m., with the reservation that during the installation of the infrastructure (i.e. from During the assembly of the infrastructure (i.e. from 28.08.2023 from 7:00 a.m. to 3.09.2023 until 10:00 p.m. and on 8.09.2023 from 6:00 p.m. to 10.09.2023 until 11:00 p.m.) it is forbidden for the Public, Participants of the event and Participants of the Contest to be present in the area of the place, where the Contest is organized. 7.

II. ORGANISATIONAL PROVISIONS

(1) Registration of participants and spectators of the event takes place via the website: <https://euroskills2023.org/pl/zarejestruj-sie/>, where the registration forms have been placed.

(2) Participation in the competition is open to Competitors not older than 25 in the calendar year of the Competition. For EuroSkills Gdansk 2023 a Competitor must have their birthday on or after 1st January 1998 (01/01/1998).

(4) A contestant may only enter one competition of his choice.

(5) Each of the above-mentioned competitions shall be held according to the regulations specified for it.

(7) Participants of the Event are obliged to collect an ID badge and wear it in a visible place throughout their attendance at the Event. The public is not obliged to wear badges. The badges will be available for collection at accreditation points located at the Participants' hotels and at the 5 accreditation points located on the Event site.

(8) Upon arrival at the Event Venue, Event Participants are required to report to the reception desk to confirm attendance and to collect their badge. The obligation to move around with an ID badge does not apply to the Public, who will be admitted to the Event Venue on the basis of an e-mail confirmation of their prior registration.

III. IMAGE PRESERVATION

(1) The Organiser reserves the right to capture the image of the spectators and participants of the Event in the form of photographs and audio-visual works and to transfer these photographs and works to WorldSkills Europe. The owner of the photographs and audio-visual works is WorldSkills Europe.

(2) In connection with the proviso indicated in paragraph 1 above, the Organiser informs about the possibility of recording the image of the Event Participants in the form of photographs and audio-visual recordings, which will be made available for the benefit of WorldSkills Europe.

(3) The relevant consents regarding image preservation will be collected at the stage of registration for the Event.

(4) The consent referred to above is granted free of charge and without limitation in terms of time or territory.

(5) Consent includes the recording, processing, alteration, reproduction of materials with the captured image and their dissemination through any medium (any form of image and sound transmission), in accordance with the purpose and activities carried out by WorldSkills Europe.

(7) If you do not give your consent to the use of your image, the participant or spectator will not be able to take part in the event.

IV. SITE SECURITY

The event site is secured by the security and safety services – Międzynarodowe Targi Gdańskie S.A.

V. FIRE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS

(1) It is prohibited on the Event site to:

- a) Use of open flames and smoking,
- b) Bringing flammable, explosive, toxic materials and corrosive liquid mixtures into the Event area,
- c) Using hand-held fire-fighting equipment for purposes not related to the rescue and fire-fighting operation.

(2) In the event of a fire at the Event site, the State Fire Service must be immediately alerted from a landline telephone at 998, from a mobile telephone at 112 or by pressing the emergency button. Until the arrival of the State Fire Service, you must strictly obey the employee in charge of the rescue and firefighting operation and, upon the arrival of the State Fire Service officers, the commander of the rescue and firefighting operation.

(3) If evacuation is announced, proceed to the designated evacuation areas.

VI. SANITARY REGULATIONS

(1) Persons entering the Event premises (both participants and spectators) may be required to have their body temperature measured.

(2) A person on the Event premises shall be required to undergo a re-measurement of his/her temperature if it is determined that it is necessary to re-verify the person's health status.

(3) Persons who refuse to submit to a body temperature measurement or who are found to have an



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elevated body temperature above 38.0 C will not be admitted to or will be removed from the Event premises.

(4) Persons who are confirmed to have symptoms of COVID-19 (in particular a body temperature of at least 38.0 C and above, persistent coughing, difficulty breathing or other flu-like symptoms) or who are suspected of having COVID-19 will not be admitted to or will be removed from the Event premises.

(5) All sanitary restrictions must be observed on the Event site in accordance with current legislation and the recommendations of the relevant authorities.

(6) Hand disinfection facilities will be available at the Event site.

VII. LIABILITY

(1) The Organiser is not liable for any damage or loss to the property of the Event Participants to the extent that such damage or loss is not caused by the Organiser's act or omission.

In particular, the Organiser is not liable for property left on the Event premises.

(2) The Event Participants are liable for damage caused by their act or omission.

In the case of damage caused by the act or omission of minors, the responsibility lies with their guardian present at the Event.

VIII. FINAL PROVISIONS

(1) The Rules and Regulations are valid for the entire duration of the event.

(2) The Rules and Regulations may be amended for important reasons, in particular in the event of changes to generally applicable laws applicable to the event.



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
